{*256} This will acknowledge receipt of your letter of July 24, 1946, in which you request the opinion of this office on whether laws regulating **hours of employment** in New Mexico are applicable to students enrolled in a school of cosmetology.

There are several different laws in New Mexico which regulate the **hours of employment** for both male and female employees. However, it is my opinion that none of these laws apply to hours of attendance of students enrolled in a school of cosmetology since a student, as such, is not an employee (See 14 Words and Phrases 365).

The hours of attendance of such students would be fixed by rules and regulations promulgated by the school.
