## 13-1605. Ordinary care of minor.

A person ι	under 18 years of age is not necessarily held to the same standard of
conduct as an ad	lult. By the term "ordinary care" with respect to a minor, I mean that
degree of care w	hich a reasonably careful minor of the age, mental capacity and
experience of	(plaintiff - defendant - decedent) would use
under circumstar	nces similar to those shown by the evidence in this case.

## **USE NOTES**

This instruction should be given when there is an issue as to the negligence of a minor seven (7) years of age or older unless the court finds that the minor has assumed the responsibility of an adult by engaging in certain activities such as driving a motor vehicle.
