

14-6013. Special verdict; [use of a firearm]1; [noncapital felony against a person sixty years of age or older].

If you find the defendant guilty of _____, then you must determine if the [crime was]¹ [crimes were] committed [with the use of a firearm]¹ [against a person sixty years of age or older, and that person was intentionally injured] and report your determination. You must complete the special form to indicate your finding. [With respect to any crime,]² For you to make a finding of "yes," the state must prove to your satisfaction beyond a reasonable doubt that that crime was committed [with the use of a firearm]¹ [against a person sixty years of age or older, and that person was intentionally injured].
