14-3130. Possession of controlled substance; defined. ¹	
A person is in possession [of]	(name of substance) when
he knows it is on his person or in his presence, and he exercises control over it.	
[Even if the substance is not in his physical presence,	he is in possession if he
knows where it is, and he exercises control over it.] ²	
[Two or more people can have possession of a substance at the same time.]	
[A person's presence in the vicinity of the substance of	or his knowledge of the
existence or the location of the substance, is not, by itself, po	ossession.]

USE NOTES

- 1. This instruction is designed to be used in controlled substance cases in which possession is an element and is in issue.
- 2. One or more of the following bracketed sentences may be used depending on the evidence.
