## 13-840. Impossibility or impracticability of performance.

When the performance of a contract obligation becomes impossible or	
unreasonably burdensome because of circumstances or events beyond the	
(promisor=s) control which are substantially and materially	
different from what both	( <i>plaintiff</i> ) and
(defendant) reasonably anticipated would exist, then the	
(promisor) is excused from performing that contractual obligation.
